March is packed with fun, so mark your calendars and join the festivities!

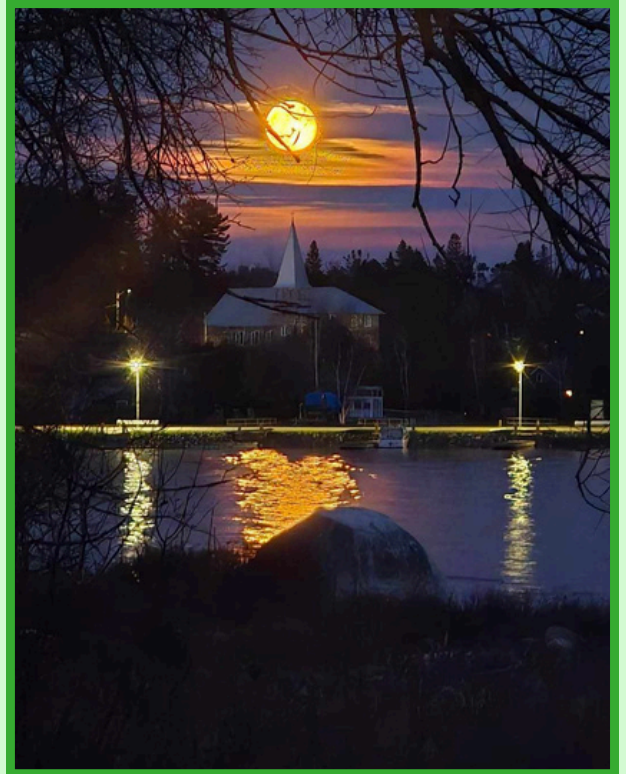

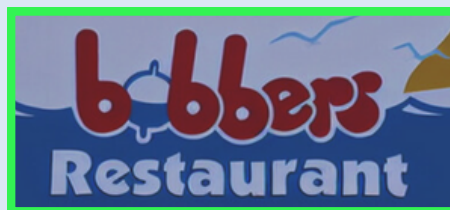
